DECEMBER 7 - 11

- Village Forest Road will be closed for asphalt patching where the utility lines were installed and is expected to continue into the following week.
- Dirt will continue to be hauled from The Hawthorne excavation area.
- Expect this to continue into next week.
- Foundation work on the gate house will begin this week. Expect drilling to continue throughout the day.
- Foundation work will also begin on The Hawthorne. Drilling will be expected at this site as well.
- Construction in the Corrigan building is expected to start soon. Contractors will be continuing exploratory work to prepare.

On Dec. 1 Forefront Living hosted two virtual ceremonies at 8:30 a.m. and at 2 p.m. to celebrate the groundbreaking of the Hawthorne, Presbyterian Village North's new independent living expansion, with current and future residents.

With the project expected to be complete in 2022, the building will offer a direct connection to the heart of the campus and feature 112 apartment homes with eight different floor plans. As with other independent living residences at PVN preferred access to assisted living, memory care, skilled nursing care, and comprehensive rehabilitation services are available. Maintaining the park-like feel at PVN, The Hawthorne will have secure underground parking for residents and with PVN's convenient location offer access to spectacular amenities, along with all of Dallas, just around the corner.

Doug Hawthorne, along with Tim Mallad, Phil Wentworth, and Bryan Cooper were featured as panelists as part of the virtual event. In addition to sharing insight into the history of PVN, a <u>time-lapse</u> of the construction from when it initially started in October until now was played. The ceremony ended with a celebratory toast.
